After a long discussion by the board of directors along with the Michigan Walleye Tour Tournament Director it has been determined that the 2020 Michigan Walleye Tour will be canceled. This was not an easy decision but in the interest of everyone involved we have chosen to do so. Our plan is to keep the same schedule for the 2021 season.

We will be keeping the 2019 Championship July  $11^{th}$  and  $12^{th}$  as previously scheduled. This has been moved to Au Gres. The teams that already qualified and paid for this will still be in the event. The boundaries will remain the same.

Saginaw Bay and Lake Huron waters with a North/South boundary of N 44.25.000 and East/West Boundary of W 82.59.000

There will also be a Saginaw Bay Walleye Club event on July 11<sup>th</sup> out of Au Gres. This will be a 3-person event one-day shootout at \$250 per boat. July 12<sup>th</sup> will be used as a blow day.

This first event will be limited to 100 boats, with 25 of the boats being from the championship. Boats already signed up for the Standish event will take priority on the list of 100 boats.

A second event will be on August 8<sup>th</sup> once again out of Au Gres with blow day on August 9<sup>th</sup>. This events boundary will be as far as your gas tank will take you.

This second event will tentatively be limited to 100 boats. If the government allows for loosening of the restrictions we will increase the amount of boats accordingly.

This event will also be \$250 per boat and a 3-person team.

All Michigan Walleye Tour rules will apply to these events.
